“STL” JUNIOR CHAMPION TOURNAMENT RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY

STL Junior Champion Handicap Scholarship Tournament is open to 2009-2010 USBC Youth members. Participants will be required to show USBC membership card at check-in. USBC Tournament Certification applied for.

2. AVERAGES

- The bowler's highest 2009/2010 league Average of 21 games or more as of 01/07/10 will be used. If an average does not exist, then;
- Highest 2008/2009 league average of 21 games or more. If an average does not exist, then;
- Bowlers who do not meet any of the above requirements will be entered with a 200 average.
- Any bowler who has only a USBC Sport League Average must utilize the chart which will determine the adjusted average to be used, Rule 202d. Chart can be found on Bowl.com.
- Rule 319a-2 and 319a-3 is waived. All averages will be verified and corrected.
- Rule 319e is waived.

3. TOURNAMENT DIVISIONS – SINGLES

Double Divisions will be determined as follows:
Master Div. -----180 & Over
Division A ----- 130 - 180
Division B ----- 129 & Under

4. OPTIONAL CROSSOVER VARIABLE DOUBLES

There will be only one OPEN division for the optional crossover doubles.

5. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Three (3) games will be bowled on the same pair of lanes. The top 5 bowlers in each Singles Division will bowl a Step Ladder Format for 1st – 5th Scholarship Placement. If there are less than 45 entries in a division, placement will be based on handicap series based on 1:8 ratio without the Step Ladder competition.

6. HANDICAP

Singles Handicap based on 90 % of the difference between the bowlers average and 200 Crossover Variable Doubles Handicap based on 90% of the difference between team average and 400.

7. LANE COURTESY

One-lane courtesy is required and will be enforced.

8. FEES

Singles Entry Fee is \$25.00 per entry: Fee breakdown is \$14.00 Scholarship, \$6.00 Lineage and \$5.00 Tournament Expense.
Optional Crossover Variable Double Entry Fee is \$30.00 per team entry: Fee Breakdown is \$25.00 Scholarship and \$5 Tournament Expense.

9. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION

Multiple participation in the Singles and Optional Crossover Variable Doubles events will be allowed. The Bowler's highest handicap series will qualify for scholarship placement. Crossover Variable double teams may qualify only once for scholarship placement.

10. SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

Scholarship Awards for Singles will be distributed 1:8 ratio. Placement for the Singles Event will be based on the handicap 3 game series of the bowler.

Scholarship Awards will be distributed for the Optional Crossover Variable Doubles 1:10 ratio. Placement for the Doubles Event will be based on the combined handicap 3 game series of each bowler on a team this will determine placement in that division.

Scholarships will be distributed 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament. All scholarships will be held in SMART (#11657). Recipients will receive notification from the tournament as to the final placing and amount of the scholarship award. The final results will be posted on Bowl.com.

11. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Any protest or appeal concerning scoring must be made in writing. Stating briefly the grounds of the protest and submitted to the Tournament Director no later than 24-hours after game has been played.

13. SUBSTITUTES

Substitutes will not be allowed..

14. DRESS CODE: WILL BE ENFORCED!!!

Bowlers must wear full-length pants and collared shirt (polo). Girls may wear knee length skirts. Shorts or jeans will not be permitted.

15. EATING – DRINKING – SMOKING

Any junior bowler caught smoking during tournament play will be disqualified. There will be no food or drinks allowed on the lanes during tournament play.

16. OTHER RULES

The 2009/2010 USBC Playing Rules will be enforced. Teams arriving late shall begin play and the scores shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Entrant will receive a zero for all frames missed. Tournament games cannot be re-bowled, except as authorized by the tournament management when scores are irretrievably lost in the scoring process. Only competitors and tournament officials are allowed in the bowling area. Tournament management has the authority to make decision regarding anything not covered by USBC rules.

Athletes/Parents/Guardians are responsible for checking with a compliance officer and/or academic counselor at the athlete's school to ensure compliance with high school and collegiate eligibility rules. Athletes under the age of 18 are under the governance of their parent/guardian for the duration of the Tournament.

Bowlers will stay on their lanes while bowling, unless excused by a Tournament Official.

- Violation of any rules or falsification on any entry will result in automatic disqualification of the bowler(s) with no refund of entry fee(s).
