CHICAGOLAND USBC HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

On Sunday, October 28, 2007 the Chicagoland USBC Association inducted 10 bowlers into the Hall of Fame at their First Combined Hall of Fame Awards Dinner out of which 2 are either past or present members of The National Bowling Association's Chicago Bowling Senate.

Joslyn R. Jennings "Super J" for Superior Performance. Jake Greene was Super J's first coach. She bowled her 1st 800 series in a tournament, her 1st 300 game in the Toni Allison Ladies Scratch League and another two weeks later. In August of 1989, paired with Cheryl Daniels they captured the LPBT Championship Doubles Tournament. She has an 803 Series and 3—300 games. Local titles include: 1st Place in the IWBA State Singles and All Events Champion. Awards include: CWBA Bowler of the Year; Singles Champion and Doubles Champion with Claudine Walker.



Maurice E. Smith for Meritorious Service. Maurice was asked by the Pastor of his Parish to participate in a Recreational Committee to put together programs that would involve both adults and youth which led to the establishment of both Senior and Youth bowling programs. He completed a Bowling Coach Seminar and went on to serve for over twenty years as the President of his Parish's adult bowling league as well as coaching the AJBC Junior League. In 1973 he became a CMBA Director, then President and ultimately a Life Member. Mr. Maurice Smith is currently serving as a Director for IBA. Maurice is currently a member

of TNBA.

Roger G. Stewart for Meritorious Service. Roger has many accomplishments that include several honor scores and a second place finish in the Hoinke Singles Event. His highest league average was 217. He bowled his first 3 games at Starlite Lanes with a former college classmate and from that evening on his passion for the sport escalated. Roger joined the CMBA Board in 1985 as a Director, and became President in 1992. He became the Executive Director of the CMBA in 1999 and is currently serving his second year as Association Manager for the Chicagoland USBC Association.

Angela "Angie" Reed was awarded "Bowler of the Year". Angie began bowling at the tender age of 8. She was a member of the Cascade Youth Bowling League. Angie has also achieved a number of accomplishments over the years. In 2003, she won the Dears Singles Classic in Cleveland, OH. That same year, Angie won the 2nd Annual Sweetest Day Mixed Doubles Tournament in Chicago. In 2006, Angie came in 2nd place in the Bill Rhodman Central Scratch Singles Tournament in Detroit, MI and 3rd place in the Canadian Club Scratch Singles Tournament in Cleveland, OH. Angie was awarded "Bowler of the Year" by the Chicago Bowling Senate for 2005/2006 and again in 2006/2007 re-named Joan McDuffie Bowler of the Year Award. Angie has 4—300 games. Angie is also currently a member of TNBA.

As a special mention, Carmen E. Phason was inducted "In Memoriam". Carmen loved the sport of bowling. She loved it so much that at one point she bowled in 5 leagues on 5 different nights. That was a lot considering Carmen did dialysis three times a week. Her highest game ever was 286 and her highest series 700 plus. Carmen began working at Lakewood Bowl in 1997. She became a manager, and loved working there; and continued to do so until her last day on earth. Carmen's husband, Robert, noted that he was disappointed that he never had the opportunity to see her shoot a perfect game. Family and friends expressed that although Carmen is gone from us, her dedication, and passion for the sport of bowling will forever be present.
