Rules.....IMPORTANT.....Read Carefully

1. The entry deadline is 9 p.m., June 27, 2010. The full amount of fees must accompany the entry.
2. **NO PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Send fees by Money Order, Bank Check or Certified Check for advanced reservations.
3. Entries for *SINGLES ONLY* or *DOUBLES ONLY* will be accepted. Doubles must consist of one man one woman only.
4. Multi-participation is allowed. A bowler may bowl as often as he/she wishes but cash only once in the Singles Prize List. Doubles bowlers may bowl as often as they wish, but can cash only once in the Prize List with the same partner.
5. **AVERAGE REQUIREMENTS:** Please read carefully: The average to be used will be determined in the following order:
 - a. Highest book average from 2008-2009 winter season based on 21 games or more.
 - b. If no 2008-2009 winter season average, the highest 2009-2010 USBC winter season average based on a minimum of 21 or more games.
 - c. When a bowler's 2009-2010 USBC winter season average is 10 or more pins higher than the previous season's average that average must be used (USBC Rule #319a-2).
 - d. Bowlers that have both a standard league average and a USBC SPORT LEAGUE or COLLEGIATE AVERAGE from the same season shall use the highest of these averages (adjusted).
 - e. Bowlers who do not meet any of the above requirements will be entered with a 210 average.
 - f. All entrants who have qualified for \$600 or more in any tournament event or division of an event during the 12 months prior to participation, must attach a report to the entry form showing actual score bowled and the amount of money won in each case (USBC Rule 319d).
 - g. All entrants must report any re-rate or adjustments to averages from any other tournament or event. Failure to report prize winnings, submit adjusted average under USBC Rule 319e or 319d or report any re-rates shall be cause for disqualification. The tournament committee reserves the right to re-rate averages prior to bowling.

Any bowler who has ONLY A USBC SPORT LEAGUE or COLLEGIATE AVERAGE must submit and use their adjusted Sport/Collegiate average utilizing the USBC Average Adjustment Scale. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in a lower classification or additional handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. Average corrections must be made within 24 hours after the end of the series.

6. The bowler is responsible for verifying her/his own Average, whether originally submitted by the bowler or others.

7. This tournament is open to all TNBA and USBC Members, and will be operated under the tournament rules of TNBA and USBC. Uncertified USBC bowlers may participate in the tournament by purchasing unattached USBC membership cards. Any entrant who does not hold or has not applied for TNBA membership prior to bowling will be disqualified. Unattached TNBA membership cards may be purchased at the site at a cost of \$20.00. USBC Membership cards may be purchased at a cost of \$21.00. USBC Rule 300c.
8. All handicap winners must have her/his submitted average verified by her/his CITY ASSOCIATION MANAGER. If a bowler is participating in multiple associations, verification is needed from all. **VERIFICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY JULY 8, 2010. THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED WITHOUT EXCEPTION.**
9. USBC Rule 319e - Tournament competition provision is in effect.
10. USBC Rule 319c - (Rerating) shall apply to both M EN and WOMEN.
11. Handicap for Singles will be 100%, computed on the difference between the bowler's average and 210. Handicap for Mixed Doubles will be 100%, computed on the difference between the bowler's combined averages and 420. Maximum handicap is 60 pins for women and 50 pins for men.
12. Bowlers will bowl by combination of walk-in and squads. Four bowlers will constitute a walk-in and will be permitted to bowl upon available lanes. The Tournament Director shall determine the availability as to squad or walk-ins
13. The Tournament Committee has the authority to accept or reject any entry to the Annual CBS C. Helen Becton Memorial Handicap Tournament. The decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final except where an appeal is made to USBC for further consideration.
14. After ENTRY has been received, and scheduled, NO fees shall be refunded except in dire emergency, such as strikes, lockouts, fire, etc. over which management has no control.
15. Prize Fee will be returned 100%. There will be at least one (1) prize for every 10 entries.
16. NO change of lanes after each game in any event.
17. Lane assignment shall be the responsibility of the staff, and any dispute shall be finalized by the Tournament Director.
18. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Director within 24 hours after games are completed.
19. The prize list will be prepared after the entries are closed, and the same will be posted at the lanes where the Tournament was conducted and at www.tnbachicago.org.
